What We Do



Founded in 1946, the Purdue
Outing Club has been
providing outdoor recreation
to West Lafayette students for
nearly 80 years! Today, we're
stronger than ever, with over
700 active members
participating in our trips,
social events, and other
shenanigans. We are
extremely proud to provide
students the opportunity to
make friends and memories
that will last them a lifetime.





Our members have the opportunity to participate in any of our seven sports: backpacking, canoeing, caving, climbing, mountain biking, whitewater, and winter sports. For just \$30 in dues for the year, our members gain access to our gear closet with over \$100,000 worth of gear, and our team of officers who lead trips and share their expertise with members!

Our Events





We send trips out **nearly every weekend** of the school year, mostly to destinations local to us such as southern Indiana, Michigan, and Illinois. These trips typically include 10 to 20 members each. However, we have two special events every year - POCtoberfest and the Purdue Outing Club Adventure Race (POCAR) - which always draw an amazing crowd!

POCtoberfest (pictured above) is our largest members-only trip. Every fall break, about 120 club members travel far from Purdue to explore destinations like the New River Gorge and Michigan's Upper Peninsula. The goal? To participate in **as many sports as possible** over the long weekend!

POCAR is our **largest event**, with 375 participants this year! This 48-hour orienteering adventure race takes place every winter over MLK Jr. weekend. Teams must brave the cold, navigating the course and competing to finish first!

Historically, our club has relied on two main sources of funding: membership dues and student organization grants from Purdue. However, as the university's priorities evolve, we are beginning to see the growing instability of these grants.


